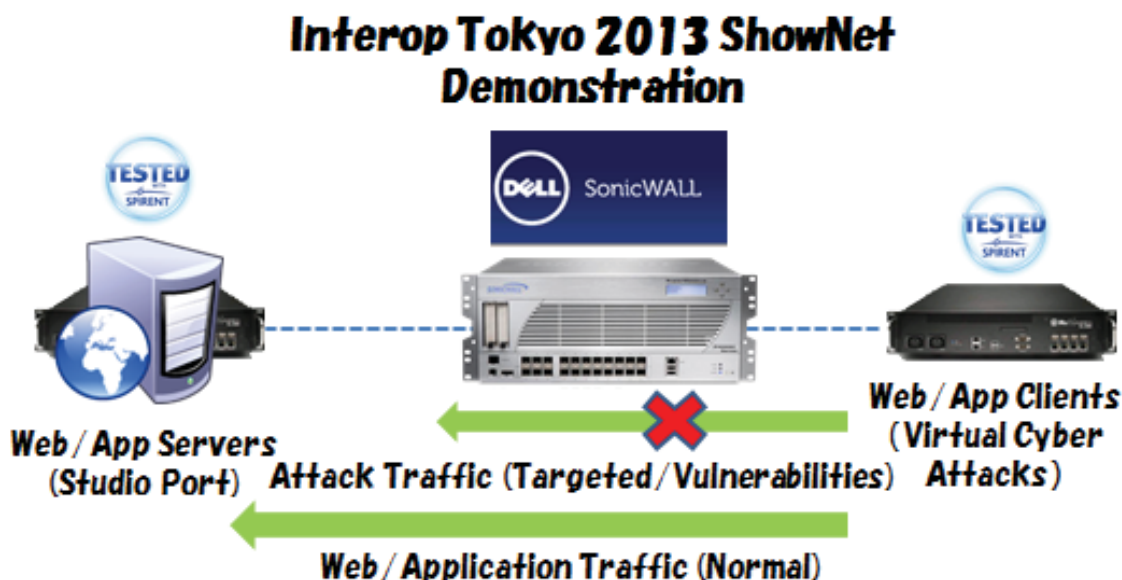

- Dell Sonicwall SuperMassive E10800 blocked application traffic and cyber-attack traffic
generated by Spirent Studio

TOYO Corporation (HQ: Chuo-ku Tokyo, President and CEO: Masaru Gomi) provided a joint demonstration with DELL Japan (President: Kohri Shinichiro) at INTEROP TOKYO 2013, one of the largest network computing exhibitions in Japan. Both Dell and TOYO exhibited their latest solutions and presented a joint demonstration using these solutions at their respective booths.

[Demonstration details]

- The next-generation security test tool, Spirent Studio of Spirent Communications, exclusively represented by TOYO in Japan, generated application traffic including traffic for Skype, YouTube and LINE and targeted attack traffic against the vulnerabilities of OS and applications. It transmitted a mixture of attack traffic and normal traffic to Dell's next-generation firewall "Sonicwall SuperMassive E10800".
- With the patented RFDPI (Reassembly-Free Deep Packet Inspection) technology, the Dell Sonicwall SuperMassive E10800 successfully blocked cyber-attack traffic, allowing high-load normal traffic to pass through it. It kept ShowNet perfectly secure while handling traffic at 10Gbps or higher (see the illustration below for more details).
